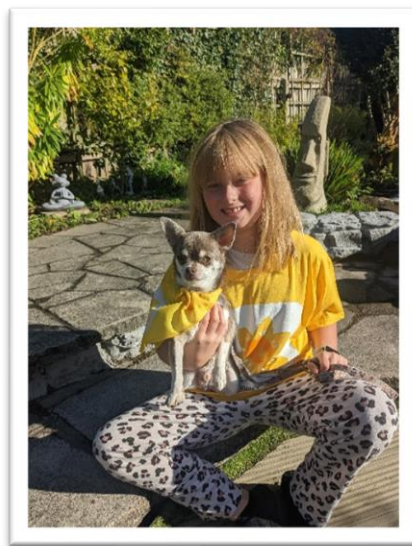
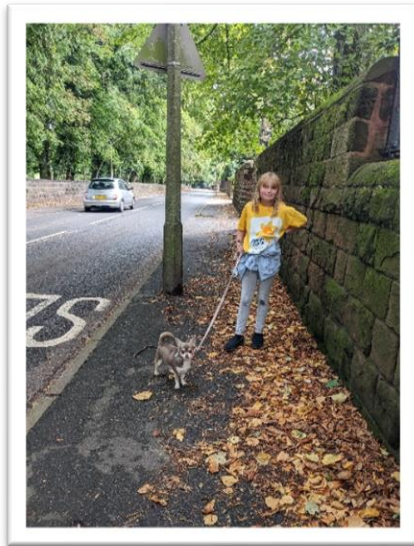
### **Fabulous Fundraiser!**
